Course Selection			
Language	Languages (mainly Japanese and English) used in classes vary. For details, please refer to the list of courses available to exchange students, which will be announced separately.		
Registration	 Minimum required hours of classes per week at Reitaku University is 600 minutes. Course registration process begins before the program starts. Please note that some courses for degree-seeking students are not available for exchange students. 		
Japanese Language Courses	At Reitaku University, we offer classes according to the purpose of Japanese language study and placement test.

Insurance			
National Health Insurance	All exchange students staying in Japan must enroll in this insurance, which costs approximately 1,500 yen per month. By enrolling in the National Health Insurance, the co-payment for general medical expenses, such as colds and cavities, will be reduced to 30%.		
Other Insurance	We recommend that you arrange your own travel insurance.		

Cost		
Tuition	The tuition fee depends on the number of registered credits. The maximum tuition fee is 150,000 yen/semester. (10,000 yen per credit) In addition to tuition, textbook fees are required separately.	
Dormitory	On-campus dormitory* 1st semester: JPY406,000 (Dormitory JPY326,000 and Entrance fee JPY80,000) 2nd semester: JPY326,000 (Electricity, gas, water, bedding rental and Wi-Fi are included) *In principle, all students will reside in the on-campus dormitory. However, if there are not enough rooms available, some students may be assigned to an off-campus dormitory. The cost will be approximately the same as the on-campus dormitory. If you are required to stay in an external dormitory, you will be contacted individually.

Wi-Fi connection	Wi-Fi fee at the dormitory is included in the dormitory fee. Free Wi-Fi is provided on campus (School ID required).

	The process for obtaining a visa to study in Japan is as follows:	
Visa	~May 9 Submit application for CoE (Partner school → Reitaku) Early-Jun: Submit application for CoE (Reitaku → Immigration Bureau) Mid-Jul: CoE issued (Immigration Bureau → Reitaku) *CoE emailed to each applicant Jul to Aug: Visa application (students →Embassy/Consulate) Visa issued (Embassy → Student)	
	Enter Japan *CoE is expected to be issued around mid-Jul 2025.	
Part-time job	Part-time work during the period of study abroad is permitted if approved by your home university. However, you must obtain a "Permission to Engage in Activities Other Than Those Permitted by the Status of Residence", which should be applied for at Narita Airport upon arrival in Japan.
