

Dear guest students and colleagues at our partner universities,

We ask you to note our **special offer regarding student exchange** for the **Summer Semester 2021**.

The lecture period is scheduled to start on 12.4.2021.

Guest students are welcome to study on-site in Jena, but also may study from abroad either part-time or full-time during the semester, depending on the scope of the courses chosen.

Our lecture programme of the coming summer semester will be published on 22 February ([more information](#)). Then will we know which format of teaching has been chosen by the academic staff. We assume that many courses, especially in advanced semesters usually chosen by guest students, will be taught online due to the ongoing pandemic. There will also be online German courses at the Language Center.

The format of exams will either be set from the beginning or be decided during the semester, depending on the development of the general pandemic situation. Students should ask the course instructors what they are planning. Depending on this, students should plan coming to Jena during the semester to take part in on-site exams in July/August.

Note that we will need your nomination of these students as soon as possible. We suggest that the students you nominate apply immediately after our invitation and have a look at the [lecture programme](#) on 22 February. If the programme does not agree with their plans, they may still cancel their stay until 31 March.

If they wish to study online from abroad, they will be sent an extra enrolment form for distance studies. They will have to pay the semester contribution like any other student (236.48€) by international bank transfer. If they need to arrive during term to take part in on-site courses/exams, they must apply for their visa as early as possible.

All student nominated based on an Erasmus+ ICM contract should still aim for 30 ECTS during their time with us – the standard workload for one semester. However, under these special circumstances we can reduce the workload to 20 ECTS should this be necessary.
