MA International Organisations and Crises Management

The IOCM application form summarises your information about the admission requirements for this programme according to § 2 of the study regulations (see box below).

You will be admitted to this programme if you meet the following requirements:

1. You hold a first professional qualification (Bachelor with 180 credit points or equivalent) with at least 90 credit points in the field of Political Science and an overall grade of 1.5 (approx. “very good”) or better.
2. You have acquired at least 20 credit points from classes focused on international relations or international organisations.
3. You have acquired at least 15 credit points in qualitative and/or quantitative research methods.
4. You have completed at least one job-oriented internship in international relations or international organisations or studied one semester abroad.
5. Your proficiency in English corresponds to level C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

If you do not sufficiently meet any of the first four requirements, but your overall grade is at least 2.3 (approx. “good”) and your studies, CV and motivation letter indicate a particular fit for our programme, you may also be admitted upon consideration of the following criteria:

- The scope and grades of those of your courses that are particularly relevant for our Master’s programme as well as the final thesis of your first academic qualification.
- Your international experiences as they relate to our programme.
- Your practical experiences and additional qualifications that are relevant for our programme.
- Your individual areas of interest and reflections on the content and requirements of our Master’s programme, as indicated in your letter of motivation and CV.

Please attach proofs of your study abroad, internships, final thesis, practical experiences and additional qualifications in your application. Use an annex to provide any additional information if necessary.

3. Please list completed modules amounting to at least 15 credit points from courses on qualitative and quantitative methods of empirical social science.

If you do not meet this criterion, you will be required to fulfil it during the first three semesters of the programme.
