# **TEACHING AWARDS 2024**

In addition to a general teaching prize, which is awarded to the best course concept, the University of Jena also awards a themed teaching prize ( $\{2,500\}$ ). In 2024, the award will be presented in the thematic focus area "Special commitment to teaching".

## TEACHING AWARD CEREMONY

The award ceremony and presentation of the award-winning teaching concepts or nominated teacher(s) will take place as part of this year's DIES LEGENDI – Teaching Day on 19 November 2024.

### SELECTION PROCESS

#### WHO SELECTS THE AWARD WINNERS?

The panel of experts of the Academy for Teaching Development selects the award winners on the basis of the nomination documents received.

#### WHAT ARE THE SELECTION CRITERIA?

The Thematic Teaching Award 2024 can be awarded to teachers whose teaching is judged to be outstanding according to at least one of the following criteria:

- The teacher creates a particularly learning-promoting climate in their own course(s) and establishes learning-promoting relationships in the respective learning groups.
- The teacher enables students in a special way to penetrate the learning content and achieve the desired learning outcomes.
- The teacher creates ideal external working conditions. The structural and organizational design of the course allows students to concentrate on the learning content in a special way.
